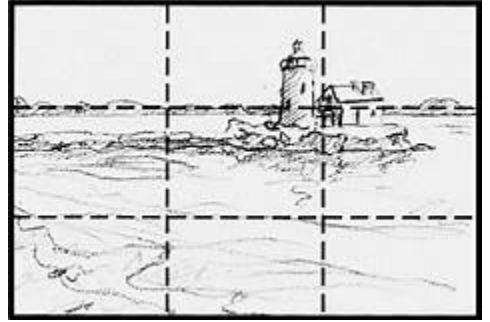


7. Study of Composition and Light. Taking your art to a new level

This workshop will be a study in artistic balance of shapes, lines and colours. Basic to advanced study of perspective. After this class you will understand your natural instincts of sensing light, composition and line and will be able to consciously use this knowledge to enhance the quality and success of your art and enjoyment of the creative experience. You will appreciate art more when you understand the visual language of relationships within a piece of art.



Materials: Large Sketch Pad, Grid paper (8x10 or larger), Charcoal or coloured chalk, Good quality pencils, Kneaded Eraser, ruler, calculator, fine tip marker. Collection of photos that you find appealing for the purpose of creating a drawing or painting.
